COLUMBUS – COVID-19 drive-thru, pop-up testing sites will be available in Columbus on October 8 and October 10. Anyone can get a no-cost test at these locations. No appointment is needed; anyone can arrive on the scheduled day. A health care provider's referral is not needed. Quantities may be limited.
