Two-day course for senior drivers returns to health department

If you are over the age of 50 and feel like life is speeding by – literally – you might be interested in a refresher driving course. A lot has happened in the 30-plus years since you first got behind the wheel: more gadgets to operate, more vehicles on the road and more distractions that pose a danger when driving.

To help you navigate these changes, the Safe Communities Coalition is bringing back the popular two-day course, *Safe Driving for Mature Drivers*, it hosted earlier this year.
