



To get to the Cooper Progress Park Vaccination Site, follow these directions:

- ➡ Travel to Mount Vernon, via S.R. 13, S.R. 229, or U.S. 36, and head for West High Street which is easily accessed off of the Public Square in downtown Mount Vernon. Travel to the end of West High St., just past Riverside Park (about 14 blocks).
- ➡ Turn onto Dike Road, which will circle around Riverside Park. Dike Road will turn into Greenwood Avenue. After traveling about 6 blocks, you will cross over the railroad tracks and be met by a traffic attendant who will check you in and direct you to the back entrance of the Cooper Progress Park.
- ➡ Once inside Cooper Progress Park, there will be signs and personnel to guide you.
- ➡ The vaccination site is a large warehouse building which can accommodate four lanes of vehicles. Once inside the building, you will turn off your vehicle. Medical personnel will come to your vehicle to administer your COVID-19 shot and collect paperwork. Once all qualified individuals in the vehicles have received vaccinations, all vehicles will exit the building to a designated parking area where they will wait for 15 minutes to watch for any adverse reactions. After 15 minutes, vehicles will then be directed to exit the parking area onto West Chestnut St.

PLEASE DO NOT take side roads to get to the clinic. Even if you are familiar with the area, it is important that you follow the traffic pattern to ensure that cars stay safe and orderly.
